



WINTER 2021 SEASON DOMESTIC REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The Southern Peninsula Basketball Association's Winter 2021 domestic season will begin on **Monday April 19th, 2021.**

All divisions will run a 3 round grading period, after which, the results will be reviewed and teams will be allocated into divisions as required.

At the beginning of round 4, all ladders will be reset to zero and all points from there on will contribute to the seasons results.

(Note: SPBA reserve the right to move teams after the grading period finishes to ensure the fairest competitions possible.)

All players who take the court **must** be registered and insured. SPBA need to have all player information of those playing every night to ensure contact tracing can occur if any situations arise. A fill in player can play a maximum of 2 games

**In addition to this document, please read the SPBA Return to Play document for all of the changes that have occurred as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. This includes venue entry requirements, game payments, sanitising procedures and facility safety.*

TEAM ENTRIES

All domestic team and player registrations are to be done via the new Play HQ platform. This has replaced SportsTG.

Southern Peninsula Basketball Association's (SPBA) junior domestic competition will, begin the process of aligning all competition teams to play for a domestic club. All SPBA **junior** domestic teams will now be required to be affiliated to a club to be able to register for the Winter 2021 domestic season and beyond. **Club contact details can be found on page 9.**

All junior team entries are to be completed by their domestic club representative. Any existing under 18 independent team will be entered into the competition by their team contact.

All senior team entries are also required to be completed by a nominated team contact.

Players who had paid for the Winter 2021 season which did not go ahead, will be provided with a 1 time code to be applied when registering for Winter 2021 so the outstanding amount, after Summer registrations will be will be discounted from their registrations.

This will be sent via email to the registered email addresses of those who it applies to and cannot be used more than once. Anyone who incorrectly uses this code will be removed from the PlayHQ data base and be required to complete their registration again.

Team registrations are to be completed online via Play HQ.

A \$200.00 fee will apply to any team that withdraws from the competition after round three of the competition.

Fixtures will be made available online approximately one week before the first round.

All fixtures are subject to change and we recommend not printing off the website.

Representative Players

All domestic teams are allowed a maximum of 8 points per team.

VJBL First side player = 3 points

VJBL Second side player = 2 points

VJBL Third side player = 1 point

**Players playing in an older age group lose 1 point*

eg. First side player = 2 points, Second side player = 1 point etc.



There are two steps to entering online:

Step 1. (For seniors and existing under 18 independent teams only)

- Click on the link to create your team (no payment required).
- You will need to create a new team and choose the appropriate competition.
- You will be provided with a team link to provide to your players so that they can complete their registration.

Step 2. – All teams

- Each player, coach and team manager, must register online with their own active email address.
- Play HQ accounts will need to be created for all first time registrations.
- Simply choose your role (player/coach/team manager).
- Use the team link provided to your team contact on registration.

Members playing in more than one team, are only required to pay registration fees once.

Please email your club contact for junior club teams, or our competitions manager for senior teams, with any additional teams you will be playing in.

Juniors who are playing in a senior team will need to register into the senior domestic competition.

Please contact the competitions manager for your code to complete this process.

(Note: The system will recognise players by their email. Team managers are not able to register their team players individually. Parents/guardians must register their children for privacy reasons and to ensure all information provided is accurate.

- Team contacts must be 18 years of age or older.
- The team contact details must be the team's manager (not a club delegate).
- All team contacts **and** coaches (U8-U18) must provide a valid Working With Children Check Card number and expiry date.

Sunday 18th of April 2021 at 5:00pm

Teams will not be permitted to play until full payment has been made for a minimum of five players.

All players who take the court must be registered and insured. Fill in's can play a maximum of 2 games only. SPBA need to have all player information of those playing every night to ensure contact tracing can occur if any situations arise.

INSURANCE / BASKETBALL VICTORIA LICENSE

Please ensure you enter your first name, surname and date of birth the as it appears on your previous registrations. You will be required to pay this licence if your insurance expires at any point during the domestic competition season you are registering into.

For those needing to purchase insurance/license for the upcoming Winter 2021 domestic season the costs are now as follows:

\$25.00 per junior player (U18y/o), annually.

\$39.00 per senior player (+18y/o), annually.

This will cover participants for a 12 months period, from the date of purchase.

FORFEIT FINES

NOTIFIED FORFEIT

\$65.00 incl. GST.

2 Business days or more notice given.

UNNOTIFIED FORFEIT

\$130.00 incl. GST.

Less than 1 business day notice given.

Failure to show up to a game without notice.

Notice for Sunday and Monday competitions must be given prior to Friday 5:00pm, for a notified forfeit to apply.

Wednesday, Thursday and Saturdays, must be notified by 5:00pm the day before.

These increased amounts are reflective of the expenses that are still incurred by the association depending on when the forfeit occurs.

Teams must pay their forfeit fine before the commencement of their next game to be allowed to take the court.

Failure to do so may result in walkovers being awarded to opposition teams for games played with outstanding fines.

FINALS & ELIGIBILITIES

Eligibility for all finals is 50% of games played for the season including grading. Byes and forfeits received, count as a game played provided the player has played before or after that game.

A team giving a forfeit will not count towards finals eligibilities. All grand finals will be held on their respective nights.



ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

It is a requirement of all domestic teams and clubs to attend the SPBA Annual General Meeting. The AGM will be held in October with the date and time to be provided to all teams when it is confirmed.

Failure to attend will incur a fine as stated in the By-Laws:

1. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

1. 2.1 *Failure by teams to have at least one representative attend the Annual General Meeting will incur a fine. Independent team not attending that gives at least 48 hours notice shall be treated as a notified forfeit. Independent teams not attending and giving no notice or less than 48 hours notice will be treated as a un-notified forfeit. Except in the case of Clubs. Attendees to the Annual General Meeting can only sign for one team.*
2. 2.2 *A Club is defined as more than 3 teams governed by one body with a duly elected Secretary. In the case of Clubs the number of representatives required to attend the Annual General Meeting must equal at least 50% of the number of teams in that Club. If less than 50% of teams attend the non-attending teams shall incur the amount of a notified forfeit fine, regardless of if the team has notified.*

UNIFORMS

All players must wear matching singlets and the same colour shorts by round 3 of each season.

A player may wear incorrect shorts or singlets but the team will be penalised by 3 points being awarded to the opposition for each player with the incorrect uniform. Team shorts must all be the same colour.

Players can use any number from 0, 00 and 1–99 as per FIBA regulations. We strongly recommend teams having reversible numbered singlets to assist in colour clash situations. Numbers must be legible on both the front and back of the uniform.

Singlets can be hired from the Stadium Manager:

1-2 singlets = \$5.00

3 or more singlets = \$10.00

Teams may borrow singlets in a colour clash situation for free.

Clubs have priority in colour clash situations otherwise the first named team on the iPad for a uniform clash between two independent teams.

Pockets in shorts are not permitted. $\frac{3}{4}$ length leggings permitted as undergarments. No T-Shirts allowed under basketball singlet's.

**Compression Gear & Undergarments:**

FIBA allow players to wear compression gear.

Any compression item must be black, white or the same dominant colour of playing singlet. If there is a logo or branding on the item, it must not be visible outside of the uniform or to be the same colour as the item. Eg, black on black. The colour choice will be decided by the player's team to ensure that teams have uniformity if more than one player in a team is wearing compression gear. This means that if one player is wearing black compression gear, any other player in the team must also wear black in any compression gear worn.

Jewellery:

Rings are not accepted to be worn. Securely taped wedding bands are allowed. Piercings must be removed. No bracelets or necklaces allowed.

Hair Accessories:

No plastic hair slide combs or clips are to be worn on the basketball court. Bobby pins are allowed. No long platted hair is allowed. No plastic/metal headbands are permitted. Material headbands are accepted if they are less than 2cm in width (FIBA rules). Braided beads are only allowed if secure within a ponytail.

PRIVACY INFORMATION

By lodgement and payment of registration for the coming season, you authorise the use by the SPBA of your name, fame, image, likeness, voice, visual portrayal and reputation in the context of the sport for the purpose of advertising, promotion and marketing the sport of basketball.

MEMBER PROTECTION BY-LAWS

All team managers and coaches of all junior teams are required to have a valid working with children's check (unless exempt) **and** statutory declaration. After grading, any team that fails to meet these obligations may result in a 0-20 forfeit for each game played until rectified.

Your team manager and/or may be asked to show proof of their Working With Children's Check by SPBA staff at any time during the season.
