Purpose

The Youth League Head Coach will work with the respective program Senior Team Head Coach to develop and sustain a strong core group of athletes and coaching staff to compete in the Big V Competition. Whilst building a pathway for our Junior Representative and Youth League athletes, this position must have a clear holistic vision of now and the future.

This position works closely under the respective Senior Team Head Coach to build the Senior Program. Ensuring both teams run the same system and work together at trainings is an important part of this role.

Key Responsibilities

- Identify suitably experienced players and team staff to the program to enhance the core playing group
- Develop the core playing group with a focus on developing our own
- Conduct an extensive pre-season for the upcoming season including training and practice matches
- Deliver a training program appropriate to the competition standard, consistent with SPBA's minimum program expectations.
- Coach the team across the fixtured season
- Attend fixtured respective program Senior Team home games where games do not clash
- Implementation of the Sharks Style of Play
- Deliver the program in a manner consistent with SPBA's coaching framework and Sharks Style of Play, in consultation with the Head of Coaching & Pathways.
- Provide regular player and team feedback, including video review.
- Provide each player with individual review and feedback across the season
- Ensure the team is appropriately prepared for each fixture, including opposition analysis.
- Ensure respective team members complete their obligations as required by SPBA
- Attend Big V club functions
- Work in collaboration with the Head of Coaching & Pathways to assist in building a connection between our junior programs to our senior representative teams.

- Comply with Big V competition regulations, including player points cap and player payment requirements, and with SPBA's player payment framework. Obtain written approval from the General Manager before committing SPBA to any player or staff payment.

Child Safety and Wellbeing

Southern Peninsula Basketball Association is a child safe organisation with zero tolerance for child abuse and neglect. This is a child-related position, delivered in line with Basketball Victoria's Child Safeguarding Policy, the Child Safe Practices and Basketball Australia's National Integrity Framework. SPBA's representative teams include athletes under 18 across both the junior and senior programs, so child safety is a core responsibility of this role rather than an incidental one.

The person appointed must:

- Hold a current Victorian Working with Children Check at all times and complete SPBA's child safety induction. The appointment cannot commence or continue without a valid Check.
- Work within the scope of the role and maintain appropriate professional boundaries, avoiding favouritism, gifts, private social contact, and one-to-one unobserved contact with any athlete under 18.
- Communicate through parents or guardians and SPBA's approved channels, copying in SPBA and a parent or guardian - never private phone, social media or messaging - and never ask a child to keep communication secret.
- Ensure children are actively supervised, and that any physical contact, change-room, transport and overnight arrangements meet the Child Safe Practices.
- Use positive, respectful language and behaviour management. Never use physical punishment, or supply alcohol, tobacco, vapes, other drugs or unauthorised medication to a child.
- Photograph or film children only where directly related to their participation, appropriately, and with the required approvals.
- Act immediately on any concern, disclosure or allegation in line with the Child Safeguarding policy.

- Involvement of the Senior Team within the Junior Program
- Involvement of Junior Sharks players in the Senior Program
- Players within the respective Senior Program progressing to further higher opportunities (e.g., College, NBL1, Australian teams, state teams)
- Development of team staff as part of a succession plan
- Assisting in creating a community-based culture at SPBA

Time Commitment

Pre Season

Pre-season commences November. The Big V home-and-away season runs March to August, with finals through August & September.

Approximately 6 hours per week across training, trials and practice matches, with additional time during the recruitment and squad selection period.

In-season

Approximately 8 hours per week, comprising team training, one to two fixtures, opposition preparation and video review, individual player feedback, and communication with team staff and the Head of Coaching & Pathways. Away fixtures involve additional travel time.

Across the year

Occasional Big V and SPBA functions, junior program involvement, and a season review with the Head of Coaching & Pathways.

Applicants should consider this commitment carefully. Where circumstances limit availability at particular points in the season, this can be discussed and accommodated where possible.
